NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN on WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2016 at 4:30 p.m., the Escondido City Council of the City of Escondido will hold a Public Hearing to consider the following item:

ROSE TO FOXDALE NEIGHBORHOOD PARKING DISTRICT

REQUEST: Residents in the Rose to Foxdale Neighborhood Area have been working with staff to establish a resident parking district to discourage people outside the area from parking their vehicles in the neighborhood and alleviate parking issues. The proposed residential parking district will be the first of its kind in the City. The one-year pilot program will allow staff and residents to monitor the program’s effectiveness. Afterward staff will evaluate the program, report information to the City Council, and seek direction to extend, modify, or terminate the program. Residents will be permitted one parking permit per residence plus one guest parking permit with proof of residency. Parking enforcement will commence within 30 days after City Council adoption of the Parking District in order to allow residents adequate time to acquire permits. The parking restriction time frames shall be 7 days a week between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. with the understanding that citations will be issued when and where parking violations occur in the District. All parking violators will be cited in the Parking District that do not have appropriate permits displayed, including residents and their guests.

PROPERTY SIZE AND LOCATION: The Special Parking District would include the area bordered by the following streets: Cherry Place to the north, Acorn Street to the south, Foxdale Place to the east, Rose Street to the west

TRANSPORTATION & COMMUNITY SAFETY COMMISSION ACTION: Approved on August 4, 2016 with a vote of 5/1/0 (Blackstock voting no)


You are encouraged to participate in the City Council meeting on September 28, 2016. This is a forum to collect opinions supporting and opposing the creation on the parking district.
