Filing a claim for a Trust Deposit does not guarantee release of that deposit. The City reviews claims and determines rightful ownership and whether or not engineering work secured by the deposit has been completed in accordance with City standards.

In accordance with Government Code 50052, if a claim is rejected, the Claimant may file a verified complaint seeking to recover all, or a designated part, of the money in a court of competent jurisdiction within the county. The copy of the complaint and summons shall be served within 30 days of receiving notice that the claim has been rejected. Funds shall be held until a decision is rendered by the court.
