

Responses to Questions on Escondido Public Library RFID/AMH
Request for Bid #17-02
November 14, 2016

Question:

I see that the new AMH system will replace an old one there. Where exactly will the materials need to go?

Answer:

The City of Escondido's *Request for Bid #17-02 Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) and Automated Materials Handling (AMH) Systems* is for a new system for Escondido Public Library and does not replace an old one. *RFB #17-02* states on page 6, under the heading Library Background, "The Library does not currently have a RFID or AMH system in place, and the current self-check units are outdated and need to be replaced. Existing 3M security gates area also obsolete and inactive."

Also, In *RFB #17-02*, under the heading Project Goals on page 7, item #4 states: "Install a materials handling system in the current circulation workroom area with a single patron internal induction point as well as a single staff induction point, located where materials are currently dropped just to the right (east) of the main east entrance door. See photos/plans in Appendix A, Escondido Public Library Diagrams and Photos, pages 46-50."

Question:

Could I stop by next week to do a walk-through of the facility? It will not take long and I'll be able to get a better understanding of the systems.
