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## 2. <u>PHG11-0005</u>, <u>Modification to CUP to Allow Upgrades and Changes at an Existing</u> Peaker Generating Plant, 1968 Don Lee, M-2 Zoning

Applicant: Paul Cummins, Wellhead Electric Company, Inc., 650 Bercut Drive, Suite C, Sacramento Planner: Paul Bingham

Staff indicated that the existing Peaker Plant was now owned by the Escondido Energy Center (EEC) and that the previous owners MMC processed a conditional use permit to accommodate upgrades to the equipment that was approved by the City Council. Staff described the proposed revisions by the new owners after further study of the feasibility of the previous approval which included using a LM600 turbine, the reuse of existing components, raising the stack 10', reducing the number of hours the plant operates, which would reduce the potential pollution constituents and applying the same color as previously approved (heat resistant paint).

Board member MacDougall clarified that the existing elements were being removed and relocated. Vice-Chair Ulle clarified the architectural elevation of the gas compressor facing Mission. Board member James clarified the components and the energy generating process. Board member Rea clarified the north elevation and that the energy is to supplement (run 500-800/ hrs per year) existing energy supply.
