DEMOLITION OF BOARDED UP HOUSES TO BEGIN

In preparation for a major street improvement project that will realign the Bear Valley Parkway and East Valley Parkway intersection, the demolition of nearby boarded up homes will begin on Tuesday, February 5.

In addition to realigning the intersection and widening the roads, the project will include new curbs and gutters, major storm drain systems, landscaping, traffic signals, street lighting, removal of overhead utilities lines, and installing raised center medians. The project is expected to cost in excess of \$18 million. Funding for this project will come from Lennar Corp., which is building a housing development nearby, as well as from federal and city sources.

The City of Escondido has contracted with Clauss Construction of Lakeside to perform the demolition work.
