● Game Days:

Each division is assigned two game days, a “primary” and “alternate”. The league will try to schedule most or all of the games on the “primary” days, time permitting. However, **teams MUST be available to play on both of these days.**

● Rosters:

Individuals, excluding goalies, may NOT play on more than one team in the same “Program Area”. The three “Program Areas” are defined as follows: #1: Silver, Bronze, Copper, and Tin, #2: 30+, #3: Adult Open. The 30+ division teams may include a maximum of two younger players aged 28 or 29. Silver teams may include any players older than 16 and Bronze and Adult Open division teams may include a maximum of two younger players aged 16 or 17.

● Fee Includes:

12-game “Stanly Cup” season, includes playoffs, “Silver Skate” tournament, awards for champions, champions name on the Stanly Cup and Silver Skate trophies displayed at the center. USA inline trained referees.

● Format:

Play is 4 v 4 plus a goalie. The AHL is designed for teams that are already formed and wish to compete together. Teams register as one unit. Interest list is available for those individuals wanting to join a team.

● To Register:

Pick up a registration packet at ESC or download at www.escondido.org/sportscenter, complete the team registration form, official roster/waiver forms. Pay the team fee before the registration deadline. Current Sportscenter I.D. card is required for each player. I.D. cards can be purchased for \$20 during normal business hours: M–F: 3 p.m.–7 p.m., Sat: 8 a.m.–6 p.m. & Sun: 1 p.m.–6 p.m.

ADULT LEAGUE DESCRIPTIONS

Silver Division

The Silver division league is designed for advanced players. The level of play in the Silver division is generally for the player who desires play in a very competitive program, i.e., retired pros, returning experienced players, players converting from ice, or advanced high school players. Players competing in the Silver division cannot play in the Bronze or Copper division, except goalies (league approval required). Teams may have unlimited players over the age of 16. All under players 18 years old must sign a separate waiver for adult leagues, along with a parental signature. This division is very competitive and demands a skilled skater who is familiar with all aspects of the game. Teams are formed by captains/managers on an invitational basis. Silver division plays on Monday nights.

Bronze Division

The Bronze division is designed for intermediate level players. The level of play in the Bronze division is generally for the player who has better than average skating skills and knowledge of the game. Players competing in the Bronze division cannot play in the Silver or Copper division, except goalies (league approval required). Teams may include a maximum of two younger players aged 16 or 17. Teams are formed by captains/managers on an invitational basis. Bronze division plays on Monday nights.

Copper Division

The Copper division is designed for entry-level players. The level of play in the Copper division is generally for beginners who have less than average skating skills and for teams not of a serious competitive nature. The Copper division is our lowest level of play and is for teams learning the sport of roller hockey without conflict competing against better than average teams. Players competing in the Copper division cannot play in the Silver or Bronze division, except goalies (league approval required). Teams may not include players under the age of 18 years old. Teams are formed by captains/managers on an invitational basis. Copper division plays on Tuesday nights.

Open Division

The Open division is designed for all levels of play. The Open division was created to build an “all around” level team. This league is designed for players choosing to play more than one night a week. When building team rosters, please realize all levels of ability compete in the Open division, therefore recruit players with this in mind. Players may compete in any other division at the Sports Center. Teams may include a maximum of two younger players aged 16 or 17. Teams are formed by captains/managers on an invitational basis. Open division plays on Tuesday nights.

30+ Division A & B

The 30+ division is designed for all levels of play. The 30+ division is for players over the age of 30 years. However, a team may include a maximum of two younger players aged 28 or 29. Players may compete in any other division at the Sports Center. Teams are formed by captains/managers on an invitational basis. The 30+ division plays on Sundays.
