### **Team Formation:**

**Middle School** — All Middle Schools may have the ability to add one eligible home school player to their roster by completing a "Player Eligibility Waiver." Each Middle School can add a sister school from the same school district and form as one team.

**High School** — All JV and Varsity teams must be comprised entirely of students enrolled in that school.

During games, the team manager or coach must carry a legible copy of each player's school photo I.D. If the school does not provide a photo I.D., proof of school enrollment is required (i.e. report card, progress report, etc.)

### **To Register:**

1. Pick up a registration packet at Escondido Sports Center or web page.
2. Complete the team registration forms and the official roster.
3. Pay the team fee before the registration deadline.
4. \*\*A current Sportscenter I.D. card is required for each player. ID cards can be purchased for \$20 during normal office hours Monday through Friday: 3pm–7pm., Sat: 8am–6pm & Sun: 1pm–6pm.

### **Game Days:**

Each division is assigned game days, a "primary" and "alternate". The league will try to schedule most or all of the games on the "primary" days, time permitting. However, **teams MUST be available to play on both days.** It is possible teams will have regularly scheduled games on both the "primary" and "alternate" game days.

# SCHOOL LEAGUE DESCRIPTIONS

## Middle School

The middle school leagues are designed for players attending 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, or 8<sup>th</sup> grade. (Under "special circumstances" a 5<sup>th</sup> grader may be eligible to play, but they must have **league approval** to be on the roster.) The roster must consist of all players from the participating school with the following exceptions:

- If a student is home schooled but his/her residence is within the boundary to attend the participating school.
- If a student attends private school but his/her residence is within the boundary to attend the participating school.

Each school league will allow six teams per ability level and four divisions within a league. The division names are: Gold, Silver, Bronze, and Copper. Gold is the highest level.

## Jr. Varsity

The Jr. Varsity school leagues are designed for players attending 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade. (Under "special circumstances" a 12<sup>th</sup> grader may be eligible to play, but they must have **league approval** to be on the roster.) The roster must consist of all players from the participating school with the following exceptions:

- If a student is home schooled but his/her residence is within the boundary to attend the participating school.
- If a student attends private school but his/her residence is within the boundary to attend the participating school.

Each school league will allow six teams per ability level and four divisions within a league. The division names are: Gold, Silver, Bronze, and Copper. Gold is the highest level.

## Varsity

The Varsity school league is designed for players attending high school. The roster must consist of all players from the participating school with the following exceptions:

- If a student is home schooled but his/her residence is within the boundary to attend the participating school.
- If a student attends private school but his/her residence is within the boundary to attend the participating school.

The exceptions do not pertain to SDCRHC rules.
