NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to California Government Code § 54974, that an unscheduled vacancy exists for the following:

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

The Historic Preservation Commission is a seven-member volunteer committee that develops the City Historic Preservation Program under the direction of the City Council. They advise the Council on the responsibilities of being a Certified Local Government and other matters relating to historic preservation. This includes:

- Maintaining and updating the Escondido Historical Sites Survey
- Recommending and maintaining a program of economic and other incentives
- Reviewing and commenting on applications for development pertaining to historic resources
- Conducting public information educational and interpretive programs pertaining to historic resources

Meetings are held on the third Thursday of every other month at 3:00 p.m. at City Hall. The Committee falls within the guidelines of the Brown Act (*California Government Code §54950, et seq.*) and all meetings are open to the public. In addition, members are required to file Conflict of Interest Statements on an annual basis.

Applicants must reside within the geographic boundaries of the General Plan. A *resume must be submitted with all applications*. Preference is given to Historians, owners of historic structures, members of the Historical Society or any formally approved Historic District.
