

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF ESCONDIDO, CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 28 OF THE
ESCONDIDO MUNICIPAL CODE TO AMEND
THE TRAFFIC SCHEDULE FOR TRUCK
ROUTES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Escondido approved a Comprehensive General Plan update by Resolution 2012-52(R) on May 23, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Escondido certified and approved the Final Environmental Impact Report ("EIR") issued for the Comprehensive General Plan Update by Resolution 2012-53(R) on May 23, 2012, that included the Mobility and Infrastructure Element; and

WHEREAS, the General Plan includes a Mobility and Infrastructure Element identified certain streets of the circulation plan as truck routes as depicted in Figure III-9; and

WHEREAS, the Escondido Municipal Code Section 28-5, authorizes the City Council to establish and amend traffic schedule for truck routes; and

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 35701 provides that a city may, by ordinance, prohibit the use of a street by certain commercial vehicles and states that the ordinance shall not be effective until appropriate signs are erected indicating either the streets affected by the ordinance or the streets not affected, as the local authority determines will best serve to give notice of the ordinance.

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to place appropriate signs on truck

routes or prohibition signs on other streets frequented by cut-through commercial traffic will improve public safety and is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Escondido, California, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. That Escondido Municipal Code, Chapter 28, Article IV, section 28-128(a) is hereby amended by replacing all references to a maximum gross vehicle weight of three (3) tons with a maximum gross vehicle weight of ten (10) tons.

SECTION 2. That Escondido Municipal Code, Chapter 28, Article IV, section 28-128(b) is hereby repealed and replaced as follows:

The provisions of subsection (a) shall not apply to any vehicle owned by a public utility or a licensed contractor while necessarily in use in the construction, installation or repair of any public utility.

SECTION 3. That Escondido Municipal Code, Chapter 28, Article IV, is amended by adding section 28-128(c) as follows:

It is unlawful to operate a vehicle with a maximum gross vehicle weight of ten (10) tons on city streets unless on a designated truck route or unless otherwise exempt from this requirement.

SECTION 4. That the traffic schedule for truck routes is hereby amended as provided in Exhibit "A," attached to this Ordinance and incorporated by this reference.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY. If any section, subsection sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional for any reason by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

SECTION 6. That as of the effective date of this ordinance, all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to certify to the passage of this ordinance and to cause the same or a summary to be published one time within 15 days of its passage in a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Escondido.




