## **Approved Cleaners for Amalgam Separators**

Vacuum lines that discharge amalgam process wastewater to a wastewater facility must not be used with oxidizing cleaners including, but not limited to bleach, chlorine, iodide or peroxide. The pH of the cleaner must be above 6 and below 8. These line cleaners are approved to use with your amalgam separator:
