The City of Escondido is updating its Climate Action Plan (“CAP”), which will consist of strategies intended to guide efforts for reducing greenhouse gas (“GHGs”) emissions. WHAT’S GOING ON RIGHT NOW

With much of the outreach complete, and the CAP finalized, the City has scheduled the CAP update for public hearings. The first public hearing is scheduled with the Planning Commission on October 27, 2020. You can review the public notice and the staff report at the link below. (Please note that the staff report will be published on October 22, 2020.) After the Planning Commission’s review is complete, the item will be scheduled for a public hearing with the City Council.
