



**The Villages –
Escondido Country Club Project Proposal**

E-Newsletter – July 2017

Interested parties,

The City is currently reviewing an application to redevelop the Escondido Country Club and golf course. As part of the process, the City created a e-newsletter to provide timely and informative news about the project.

A draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) was recently prepared to identify the existing activities and uses at the Project site and evaluate how future conditions might change if the proposed Project is built. This report was released for public review and comment on June 28, 2017.

City staff wants to ensure that residents, businesses, community members, and other interest parties know of the next steps that are involved in the environmental review process and how the public can participate and review/use the DEIR. **There will be an informational open-house meeting to answer questions about the project and the DEIR on Monday, July 31, 2017 from 4:30 to 7:00 pm at City Hall, in the Mitchell Room.** The format of the meeting will allow for people to drop in at their convenience. (It is not necessary that you show up right at 4:30 pm.) The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public about what the Project is proposing, how the Project was analyzed, and identify each significant environmental effect expected to result.
