

Responses to Questions Received for Bid #17-03

Question:

Requesting a review of our standard specifications - We definitely have an equal product but we want to know if our standard construction methods, dimensions on compartment lengths, depths and bed area dimensions (which will be similar but slightly different than the Scelzi dimensions provided in the bid spec) will be acceptable and not be disqualified for not being exact.

Response:

In reference to a Scelzi 9' utility body, SCBR-108-79-49-43-VO, the overall length is 108", 79" overall body width, 49" floor, 43" compartment height, and has vertical compartments with full length open tops. The City of Escondido will disqualify a utility body that does not meet the 108" overall length (excluding bumper), 43" compartment height, and a full length open top compartment specifications. Bid evaluators will accept variations in overall body width to 82" and fluctuation in floor width dimensions
