## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Escondido Planning Commission will hold a public hearing, in the City Council Chambers, Escondido City Hall, 201 N. Broadway, Escondido, California at 7 p.m., on Tuesday, November 28, 2023, to consider the item listed below:

### SPECIFIC PLAN AMENDMENT, PLOT PLAN AND DENSITY BONUS – PHG20-0036:

**REQUEST:** The Project includes an Amendment to the South Centre City Specific Plan to expand the mixed-use overlay to the Project site to allow for residential and commercial development (mixed-use) up to 30 dwelling units per acre and building height up to 45 feet. The Project also includes a Major Plot Plan and Density Bonus for the development of a four-story building consisting of ground-floor parking garage, up to 4,200 square feet of ground-floor commercial/flex space, and 21 multi-family residential units. The Density Bonus would allow for an increase in allowable density but require 3 of the units to be restricted for “very low-income” tenants, along with certain concessions/waivers from development standards. The proposal also includes adoption of the environmental determination for the Project.


**PROPERTY SIZE AND LOCATION:** The 0.46-acre project site is located on the southwest corner of S. Escondido Boulevard and W. Ninth Avenue, addressed at 829 – 849 S. Escondido Boulevard and 332 W. Ninth Avenue (APNs 233-371-14-00 and 233-371-15-00).

**ENVIRONMENTAL STATUS:** An Addendum to the previously adopted Negative Declaration has been prepared for the proposed project in accordance with section 15164 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

If you challenge this item in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Commission at, or prior to, the public hearing.
