


Storm Drain Crossword



Storm drains are a system designed by cities to carry rainwater away from streets and houses to prevent flooding. To protect local creeks from untreated storm water runoff, only rain should go in the storm drains.



ACROSS

- 1. Put this in the garbage can where it belongs.
- 3. Divert rainwater into this to prevent runoff.
- 5. Storm drains were built to prevent this.
- 7. Only this goes in the storm drain.
- 8. An area of land where all the water drains to a single place.
- 9. Rainwater from the street goes into this.
- 10. Water you flush down the toilet goes here.

DOWN

- 2. When water flows over hard surfaces, it is called this.
- 4. When water travels into the ground, it is called this.
- 6. Our storm drains and sewer system are this.
