HOW TO GET STARTED:

Step 1: Contact Amber Tarrac to go over your unique business options.

Step 2: If you would like to setup a parklet/sidewalk dining, fill out the Business Recovery Temporary Use Permit:

Step 3: Once you receive an approval notice from the City, please let us know if you would like the City to provide temporary use fencing to keep your space safe (while supplies last).
