2. REVIEW OF FINANCIAL REPORT

Lisa Palmer, Finance, presented the Financial Report for the period ending March 31, 2008.

3. DEVELOPMENT OF THIRD ANNUAL REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY

The committee requested that Joyce Masterson prepare a draft for the Third Annual Report to the Community for the committee's approval.

4. UPDATE ON POLICE AND FIRE FACILITY

Sam McCuskey, McCuskey Group, presented an update on the Police and Fire Facility. He noted that McCuskey Group will be installing a camera so work progress can be viewed on line.

The first steel for the main building was set on May 8, 2008.

5. UPDATE ON FIRE STATIONS PROJECT

Fire Station 1:

Site grading is 100% complete. Trenching and forms are in process. Plumbing and electrical rough-in is underway. Framing will begin in about two weeks.

Fire Station 3 (Nutmeg):

Fire Station 3 is on schedule and due to be completed during June 2008.

The exterior color coat is complete and interior paint is about 80% complete. The electrical and plumbing are about 80% complete. Carpet installation began on May 8, 2008, and the landscape contractor is currently installing trees and shrubs.

Fire Station 6 (Del Dios Highway):

Fire Station 6 is about 65% complete. The stucco color coat is complete and the rock veneer is currently being installed. The electrical and plumbing trim-out is complete and all out buildings are complete.

Fire Station 7 (Ash Street):

Fire Station #7 is completely framed out. Interior electrical, mechanical and plumbing rough-in is complete and out buildings are all complete.
