3. UPDATE ON POLICE AND FIRE FACILITY

Joyce Masterson gave an update on the Police and Fire Headquarters.

The City has been granted Temporary Occupancy. Dispatch will be moved on Tuesday, May 18, 2010, and the rest of the divisions will follow with plans for all divisions to be

moved in by Saturday, May 22, 2010 and open for business on Tuesday, May 25, 2010. The old Police Department Headquarters will be closed for business beginning Friday, May 21, 2010.

All contractors have repaired their "problem" areas. Contractors have paid for any damage their work and/or employees caused.

Some of the damage could not be assigned to a particular trade, so Risk Management is working with the City's insurance company to take care of those areas. The City has received a clean Bill of Health with regard to the mold problems.
