Minutes September 10, 2009

CALL TO ORDER

The Public Safety Facilities Oversight Committee meeting was called to order at 4:35 p.m. on Thursday, September 10, 2009 in the Parkview Room at Escondido City Hall by Chairman Carl Skaja.

1. APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

The minutes from the July 9, 2009, meeting were approved.

2. REVIEW OF FINANCIAL REPORT – GIL ROJAS

Gil Rojas, Finance Director, presented the Bond Expenditure Financial Report as of June 30, 2009.

The City's financial audit will begin on October 5, 2009. This audit includes Prop P funds.

Oversight Committee members requested an opinion from the City Attorney regarding any Prop P funds remaining after the project is completed and the NOC's have all been filed. They would like an opportunity to present their suggestion to Council regarding how said funds should be distributed.

3. UPDATE ON POLICE AND FIRE FACILITY - SAM McCUSKEY

Sam McCuskey, McCuskey Group, reported that furniture is scheduled to be delivered on October 5, 2009.

Some of the sound booths installed in the ceiling were inadequate. Parts of the ceiling had to be taken down and re-installed. Painting is taking place now; carpet tile is being installed; and doors and hardware are being installed.

Substantial Completion for the Police and Fire Headquarters is projected for December 2009.

John Houchin reported that representatives from the City of El Cajon spent four hours on a tour of the Police and Fire Headquarters and they were very impressed with the building.

4. UPDATE ON FIRE STATION #1 - MIKE LOWRY

Fire Chief, Mike Lowry, reported that the bulk of the work on Fire Station #1 is complete. They are finishing up the walk-through and the punch list.

The City is hoping to have the building turned over on September 18, 2009, and would like to move in September 29, 2009.

The date for the Grand Opening has not been scheduled, but will be sometime during October 2009.

5. ORAL COMMUNICATION
